## Fees

### Deposits

Once you have received an offer letter, you are required to pay a deposit to reserve your place on the course and receive your Certificate of Enrolment. This can be used to apply for a student visa. The deposit is 50%; however, University of London students must pay the full fee. The deposit is applied towards your tuition fees and is non-refundable except in case of visa refusal.

### Early Payment Discounts

We understand that studying overseas is a major financial decision. We have therefore introduced Early Payment Discounts to help those applicants who need to plan ahead.

If you have been accepted onto a Holborn College course and wish to receive this discount all you have to do is pay your deposit by either of the dates published below. You will then be guaranteed a reduction of either 10% or 5% on the total tuition fees. This will be deducted from your second instalment.

<b>September 2009 Intake</b>	10% discount if deposit paid by:	Friday 31 July 2009
Early Payment Discount dates	5% discount if deposit paid by:	Friday 28 August 2009

### Instalment Scheme

You can pay your fees in two instalments: 50% deposit before enrolment, 50% before the start of the second term. If you pay your second instalment after the due date, your Early Payment Discount will be forfeited.

<b>September 2009 Intake</b>	First instalment (50%):	before enrolment
Instalment dates	Second instalment (50%):	before February 2010

**N.B.** LLB London and London Diploma students need to pay the full course fees before classes begin and are not eligible for early payment discounts.

**Reassessment fee:** £120 per module.

**Retake module fee:** pro-rata of gross fee.
