➤ Accommodation

It is essential to arrange accommodation before you arrive in Nottingham. Use the table below to compare cost, facilities and location and chose the best residence for you. Then apply using the attached accommodation form. Please note that accommodation cannot be confirmed until receipt of the **arrival form**.

The below residencies are all specifically for students, which means they're great places to meet new people. Utilities (such as gas, electricity and water), are all included in the rent, making them an economical and simple place to live. Shared mixed flats have between 4-9 individual bedrooms with communal kitchen/dining area. Rooms either have a shared bathroom or their own bathroom (en suite). There are laundry facilities on site. Please check the websites for detailed information.

Please note: only Cotton Mills and Liberty Square will accept students under the age of 18. Students who are under-18 must pay for the total contract on arrival and their guardian must sign the contract. **Do not forget, once you have signed a contract, you are committed to stay in the residence and pay for the accommodation for the duration of the agreement.** Deposits are refundable, subject to inspection for damage.

We strongly recommend that you apply for a place in one of these residences until you are familiar with the city of Nottingham. However, if you decide to take private rented accommodation instead, please inform Student Services of your accommodation plans before you arrive.
